The road's rich history and busy atmosphere make it an essential part of London's urban landscape.

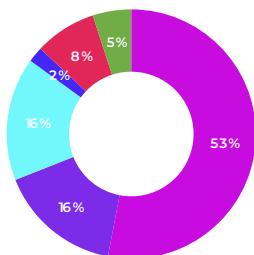
